Dining Room tables/chairs (no pressed wood)

DVDs (selectively)

Kitchen chairs/tables* (no pressed wood)

Kitchenware

Lawn furniture (red wood, wicker or wrought iron)

Ladders Lamps

Lawn mowers if in good working order

Linens & fabrics (clean)

Microwaves (in good condition)

Musical Instruments (in good condition)

Paintings-prints-frames

Records

Rocking chairs

Sewing Machines* (if featherweight/relatively new, or antique)

Golf Carts (unless relatively new & excellent cond.)

Firearms of any age or type

Sewing machine cabinets (unless very old w/treadle)
